**Russian Standard Added 11 New Export Markets in 2006; A Dozen More Planned

NEW YORK, March 1, 2007 – Russian Standard Vodka, the number one premium vodka company in Russia, today announced it has been ranked the 4th fastest growing premium spirits brand worldwide for 2006 by IMPACT magazine, the leading source for exclusive data on the alcoholic beverage industry in the United States. Russian Standard, which grew by more than 30% in 2006, ranked ahead of two of its top competitors, Grey Goose and Stolichnaya.

Russian Standard was also ranked 73rd on the “Top 100 Premium Spirits Brands Worldwide” list with 1.4 million cases sold in 2006, up dramatically from its prior year ranking of 98.

“Global demand for authentic premium Russian vodka is unquenchable,” said Roustam Tariko, founder and chairman of Russian Standard Corporation. “With our new state-of-the-art distillery fully operational, we are well positioned to continue our international expansion in 2007 and beyond.”

Russian Standard vodkas are currently exported to 40 markets around the globe. In 2006, Russian Standard made a major advance into Germany, which has become a top performing market supported by a major advertising campaign. In all, 11 new markets were added in 2006, including China, Denmark, France, Hungary, Japan, Lebanon, Peru and Switzerland. The company expects to add another dozen markets in 2007, among them India, Thailand and Turkey.

Located in St. Petersburg, Russia, Russian Standard’s new distillery possesses state-of-the-art process design and equipment that modernizes each stage of production. The facility handles production of Russian Standard’s entire vodka portfolio globally, producing up to 4 million cases per year, at a rate of 22,500 bottles in hour.
